

Art Deco Style

1925-1940



This visually stimulating and intellectually undemanding style first came into prominence at the Exposition des Arts Decoratifs et Industriels Modernes held in Paris in 1925. Art Deco motifs came to be especially favoured for both the exteriors and interiors of distinctively twentieth-century building types such as the cinema and the skyscraper.

The appeal of this style was that its sleek, clear lines were well in keeping with the rejection of previous ornate and overworked styles. This new style was sophisticated, functional and also beautiful.

As life became busier and more complex, architecture became simpler and more alluring. Art Deco celebrated the exciting, dynamic aspects of the machine age.

The glamour of the art deco style was romanticised in film, in popular fiction and in the style choices of the rich and famous.

HOW TO ORDER YOUR MOULDING

Ordering your moulding is simple. We just need the answers to a few questions:

1. Are you painting or staining your moulding?
This will determine which timber you choose. If you are painting, choose Pine or MDF.
2. Choose the appropriate timber species
3. Choose your moulding number
4. Work out the quantity required.

If you wish to match an existing moulding, we require:

1. A sample or "to scale" drawing
2. Timber species required
3. Quantity required

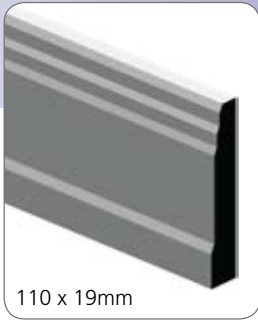
