

Federation Style

1890-1915



The general term of Federation Architecture in Australia was coined for the Edwardian style as it is called in England.

There were 12 distinct Federation Styles. For public buildings, the Classical styles dominated while for the domestic home, Queen Anne, Arts and Craft and the Bungalow were the choice of the day.

This age in architecture was characterised by the development in adornment of roofing, finials and decorative ridge tiles.

This period saw the decline in use of decorative wrought iron. It was replaced with decorative and expert ornamental woodwork. The brickwork in a building became more decorative as well.

The interest in leadlight windows continued but the interest in the long verandah gave way to the entry porch with decorative wooden additions.

HOW TO ORDER YOUR MOULDING

Ordering your moulding is simple. We just need the answers to a few questions:

1. Are you painting or staining your moulding?
This will determine which timber you choose. If you are painting, choose Pine or MDF.
2. Choose the appropriate timber species
3. Choose your moulding number
4. Work out the quantity required.

If you wish to match an existing moulding, we require:

1. A sample or "to scale" drawing
2. Timber species required
3. Quantity required

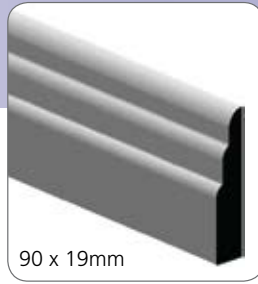
